STORMS IN LIFE

None of us like storms that bring danger, destruction, and possible death. Bad weather causes us to seek shelter. We experience fear, uneasiness, and are watchful until threatening weather passes us by.

Everyone will have stormy trials in our lives. It doesn't matter where we live, if we are rich or poor, or if we are young or old. Jesus told the story of a wise man who listened and obeyed God who built his house upon a rock. Violent weather brought heavy rains, flooding, and fierce winds that beat against his house. This man's house stood firm. The foolish man, who listened but did not obey God, built a home on the sand. A tempest brought rain, floods, and high winds against his house. It fell with a crash! (Matthew 7:24-27). Storms will assault all those who follow the Lord and those who do not. But notice that the final results were very different.

Bad things can happen without warning. Consider the case of Job's children who were eating a meal together in a house "and suddenly a great wind came...and stuck the four corners of the house," killing all of them (Job 1:19). When Jesus and His disciples were in a boat on the sea of Galilee, "suddenly a great tempest arose on the sea," putting their lives in jeopardy (Matt 8:24-25). Things may be smooth in our lives but the next moment a trial comes. It could be a phone call that a family member has been in a terrible accident. We may have a doctor's checkup and hear, "I'm sorry you have a lump" or, "your blood work shows something". Most of us remember on a beautiful morning on September 11th, an announcement came that a plane had hit a tower in New York City. Immediately things changed for us.

Disturbances in life will cause at least two things. First, they will test our faith. James said, "My brethren count it all joy when you fall into various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience" (James 1:2,3). We can grow from our trials. They will give us strength, teach us to "walk by faith and not by sight, and to wait upon the Lord to fulfill His promises (Phil 4:13; 2 Cor 5:17; Psa 62:5). Secondly, stormy problems reveal our great need for God. When children get scared during a storm, they want to be near an adult. When the followers of Jesus were in a tempest at sea, they thought they saw a ghost walking on the water. The lord said, "Be of good courage! It is I. Do not be afraid" (Matt 14:27).

We know a storm is ahead. Whatever it might be – financial, family problems, injustice, or illness – the Savior will be with us. We can find hope and peace in His promises. (John 11:25; 14:27). We are not alone in threatening times.
