A CHILD OF GOD

I John 3:1-2 *Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God!*

Everyone enjoys a sense of belonging. Among the first truths of Scripture is the picture of God our Maker (Genesis 1 & 2). There are many Biblical references to the fact of a Creator. (Isaiah 40:28; Psalm 100:3; Ecclesiastes 12:1; Colossians 1:17). In reality, the whole world belongs to God (Ps 50:10-11) *For every beast of the forest is Mine, and the cattle on a thousand hills. I know all the birds of the mountains.*

IN ORDER TO BE SAVED I MUST BELONG TO GOD THROUGH CHRIST:

Romans 8:16-17 says, “The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ. . . .” There is no other way for man to be saved. John 14:6. Jesus is the only name whereby man can be saved. Acts 4:12. When we trust Christ as Savior, then we become His possession (Gal.3:26-27). What we have “in Christ” is the theme of Ephesians (1:3). I belong to Him through His Son because that is the only way to be saved.

SINCE I BELONG TO GOD, HE IS THE SOURCE OF ALL MY NEEDS! He watches over us with His eyes (Psalms 34:15). He listens to our prayers with His ears. (I Peter 3:12). He speaks to us by His Word (Ps. 119:11). He loves us with His heart (I John 3:1-2). He supports us with His arms (Deuteronomy 33:27). He holds us in His Hand (Psalms 37:23-24). He leads us by His Spirit (Romans 8:14). He encourages us with His promises (2 Peter 1:4).

SINCE I BELONG TO GOD THEN I SHOULD LIVE AND ACT AS HIS CHILD. The greatest deterrent for others is often the way we live and act as Christians. God is our Father! We are made in His image. Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do. But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection. And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful (Colossians 3:12-15).
